ABOUT THE HOSPICE LICENSE PLATE

Florida Hospice & Palliative Care Association's (FHPCA) hospice specialty license plate is a beautiful and thoughtful way to show others the importance of having quality end-of-life care.

The plate can be purchased at your local tax collector's office or online at www.floridahospices.org. For every plate sold, \$25 goes to help fund hospice education and outreach programs, such as:

- *New products related to hospice care, including a model of care for very ill children, and improving and increasing access to end-of-life care for Florida's veterans.*
- *End-of-life care programs specific to gender and ethnic, religious, and minority groups.*
- *Education and outreach for hospice volunteers, patients, families, and health care professionals.*
- *Expansion of the toll-free referral line and website of FHPCA.*
